



## Uniform Policy

Kelso High Campus expects students to wear full school uniform every day.

As part of our Positive Behaviour for Learning ethos, Kelso High Campus students are expected to: Be on Task, Be Safe and Be Respectful. We aim to promote positive attitudes towards school and a feeling of pride amongst our students. This includes a focus on school uniform.

Our uniform ethos is supported by our Kelso High Campus Parent Focus Group, School Representative Council, Aboriginal Representative Council, teaching staff and students.

Kelso High Campus believes that a uniform is important for both safety and learning. It promotes belonging and equity, and helps to reinforce a culture of learning. In an effort to foster a positive learning environment as well as a positive image within the community, we expect every student to wear the correct uniform to school every day.

As part of the Kelso High Campus Uniform Policy we conduct daily uniform checks. On the second occasion that a student is out of uniform we notify parents and request that they help the school enforce its uniform policy by ensuring students wear the correct uniform to school each day. If for some reason the correct uniform cannot be worn on a particular day, we ask that parents provide a short note explaining the circumstances.

If a student is found to be out of uniform three times in a two-week period, this will be followed up with a phone call home and the student will attend a K2 detention. The student will also be precluded from attending non-mandatory excursions, being involved in extracurricular activities and representing the school in sporting and other events for a period of time.

If a student continues to be out of uniform after these interventions without a legitimate reason, they will be referred to the Senior Executive for persistent disobedience.

The correct uniform includes:

Tops – Boys and Girls

- White polo shirt
- White button shirt with a collar
- Denison College polo shirt
- KHC hoodie
- Any KHC jumper/shirt with the school emblem on it
- Approved senior jumper

#### Bottoms – Boys

- Black shorts (small logos)
- Black long pants
- Plain black track pants (small logos)

#### Bottoms – Girls

- Black skirt, straight or pleated
- Black shorts (small logos)
- Plain black track pants (small logo)

#### Footwear

- Enclosed shoes and in accordance with requirements of subject areas

NB: Tights, leggings, large logos/graphics on clothing are NOT permitted.

NB: Ugg boots/thongs and other soft footwear are NOT permitted.

NB: Plain black jumpers are not part of our uniform. All jumpers must have a KHC logo.
